Also he told that some of our members have suggested Hotel Hyatt & some have Hotel JW Marriott and we are working on it and in February we will come with MOACON 2026 report.

Dr. Sham Shinde said, we don't have other Hotels for accommodations near Hotel JW Marriott were we have more options near Hotel Hyatt Pune.

Dr. Karne said, though we have approved for Hotel Hyatt in online EC as per the request from members will work on JW also. And Hyatt has huge space we can do many things at same time.

Dr. Sham Shinde suggested as PCOA will also be part of MOACON 2026 along with POS, we should have the meeting of both the association.

Dr. Karne said, yes that we will do but before that POS EC should pass the resolution about the same that POS will be conducting MOACON 2026 along

with PCOA and on all promotional material there will be the logo of POS along with PCOA. So same can be convey to MOA EC.

Above applications were received to POS office since last EC meeting, and approved unanimously by EC with subject to proper documentations.

9. Report of POS Legal Committee about the amendments in constitution

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale said, we have sent an email to POS Legal Committee about the points suggested for amendments by Dr. Gautam Salunkhe. Out of 8 points we were able to resolve around 6 points and 2 points need to be discussed and resolved. Accordingly, we asked POS Legal Committee to draft the points and send to POS office and today morning we have received draft from Dr. N J Karne & Dr. Gautam Salunkhe.

Dr. Sham Shinde explained the point regarding the legitimate expenditure to be paid to member if he wins against the association.

Dr. Karne also explained the same point if member goes against the decision of GBM to court and if he wins against the association then how much amount of his expenses to be given by POS. In last meeting Dr. Pradhan suggested to give Government fees. I think we should pay whatever the lawyer fees POS will spend for his lawyer that amount we can consider to the member winning against POS. If you are giving government fees then it will be negligible charges.

Dr. Shailesh Hadgaonkar seconded Dr. Karne yes we should pay only government fees.

Dr. Ajit Damle asked what we have about the same in MOA & IOA constitution?

Dr. Karne replied, this constitution is the copy paste of MOA, their they have not accepted any of this kind of suggestions.

Dr. J B Panse said, you are talking about the legitimate charges, what I can understand you are ready to pay the charges whatever spend by POS to lawyer. So what I suggest this legitimate is the beg term and if all agree we can mention the same in clear words.

Dr. Swapnil Bhise said, we have form the Legal Committee for all this discussion let the legal committee give its report to EC then EC can take the decision on the same.

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale said, as per my talk with Dr. Swapnil Bhise, Dr. Sham Shinde & Dr. Karne sir letit be like this only "he should be given the legitimate expenditure for the Court case as awarded by Court" and at last line "The legitimate expenditure done by member as awarded by court"

Dr. Shailesh Hadgaonkar said, court can ask to pay more than government fees and if that lawyer will be charging huge fees then court may ask to pay the same.

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale said, court don't ask to pay any amount.

Dr. Karne replied, court can ask it if the association or the GB is doing grossly wrong, injustice, criminal malpractice etc. He gave an example of IOA elections were the voting process was tampered, voter list was tampered in such case court can ask to pay. But for this we have brought the Board of Trustees were if they find such thing are happening they can call GBM and put it in front of GB.

Dr. Panse said, I agree with Dr. Karne sometime words have be salient, it should be address at individual case basis.

Dr. Shailesh Hadgaonkar said, we are talking on such thing for years which is hypothetical and need to stop somewhere.

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale proposed the following amendment clause no. 7. (g) Disciplinary Action as follows,

g) Disciplinary Action: If any Life member goes in the Court of Law or Charity Commissioner against the decisions of **General Body**, he will be immediately suspended from the Association and will not have any right as Life Member. If he wins the case, he can be re-instated as a Life Member. But, if he loses the case, he will be terminated with immediate effect. for the next 6 yrs. If he goes in the appeal, which is accepted by the Court, he will remain again in suspended state. If he wins the appeal, he can be re-instated as a Life Member and he need not have to pay this Court expenditure. Rather he should be given the legitimate expenditure for the Court case as decided awarded by Court General Body. But, if he loses the case again, he will be terminated with immediate effect. The duration of this termination can be more than 6 yrs, as per decision taken in subsequent GB, by simple majority. While re-admitting those members, who are terminated because of going to the Court against decisions of GB, they should pay all legitimate the expenses incurred by the Association, while defending/fighting the case in the Court. Then only they may be considered for New membership.

It is Seconded by Dr. Sachin Nagapurkar. It is approved Unanimously. *(Resolution No. 005/EC/26Dec2024)*

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale said, now we will move to next point Power to remove difficulties point number 2.

Dr. Karne explained clause No. 26.2 in Power to Remove Difficulties. He explained why and how this point came, he gave an examples happened in MOA & IOA.

Dr. Sham Shinde Suggested if we can change the heading of this clause

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale said, actually it was started because by typo error it was written that it will be **implemented after approval of Executive Committee** but the same mistake is accepted and corrected as **implemented after the approval of General Body**. Here actual the purpose of whole discussion ends. And as Dr. Sham Shinde says, if we can change the heading of clause that can be done.

Dr. Karne said, yes it is technical thing the heading can be different in different constitution.

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale proposed, Dr. Sham Shinde will work on the heading of clause and give us the proper heading. It is Seconded by Dr. Hemant Patil & Dr. Yogesh Khandalkar. It is approved unanimously. *(Resolution No. 006/EC/26Dec2024)*

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale proposed the Executive Members to approve the draft provided by Legal Committee and to be send to POS members for amendments. It is Seconded by Dr. Sachin Nagapurkar & Dr. Kailash Patil. It is approved unanimously. (Resolution No. 007/EC/26Dec2024)

Dr. Ingale thanks all Legal Committee members for their valuable time, efforts for resolving this issue.

Dr. Shailesh Hadgaonkar said, as per the report of POS Legal committee we can decide the EGBM for the amendments in the month of February 2025.

11. Report of Webmaster - Dr. Mukesh Dharma

Dr. Gowerdhan Ingale ask Dr. Mukesh Dharma to go through the POS website and update the same also show the actual website in your report to all EC. Further Dr. Shailesh Hadgaonkar said, we have POS Facebook page and I think Dr. Arjun Viegas is the admin of it, talk with him and restrict the page to post the message to other members because some of the implant company person is regularly posting their messages on our page. So that should be restricted and not to be allowed.
